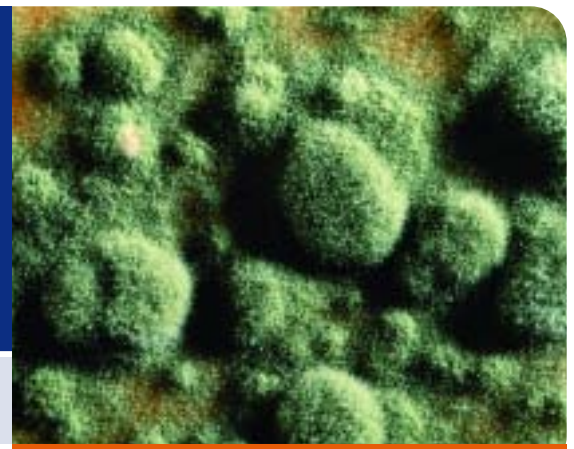

Munters stops mold growth after water damage by drying the affected environment. Desiccant dehumidifiers are used to provide extremely dry air. The treated air is ducted into the water damaged area, where it is directed into wall cavities and other hard to reach places. Instrumentation is used to monitor drying inside walls, until conditions inside the building do not support mold growth.

Implementation

Munters trained technicians will be equipped to work safely and will follow all nationally accepted guidelines for remediation. If necessary, containment procedures may call for the removal of affected materials. In this case, the procedure will be implemented and steps will be taken to prevent migration of mold spores to unaffected areas. A system involving air flow (negative pressure) and HEPA filtration will be engineered to properly contain, dry and decontaminate the affected area.

Documentation

Once drying and mitigation are completed, Munters will document that the area has been thoroughly dried and remediated. If necessary, Munters will work with third-party health professionals using post-abatement testing to establish that the project has been completed successfully.
